

SEE AND LEARN AS YOU PEDAL

FULTON: Visit the Winston Churchill Memorial. See the Berlin Wall sculpture, Visit the Auto World display of antique Fire Trucks and vintage cars.

MOBERLY: See stature of General Omar Bradley. Moberly is on a high point in between the Mississippi and Missouri Rivers and was thought to be safe from tornados. This was proved wrong on July 4, 1995, when a tornado ripped through the town.

BOONVILLE: Visit Thespian Hall, the oldest theatre in the state (on Main St.) Discover the Old Cooper County Jail, the Sheriff's Residence and the Hanging Barn. Visit Rauenuood Home (1880) and Roslyn Heights, a Victorian Mansion with 8 fireplaces.

SEDALIA: Visit the Goddard Art Gallery and the Historical Society in Pettis County. This city is also the site of Scott Joplin Ragtime Music Festival and the Missouri State Fair.

JEFFERSON CITY: The Missouri State Museum has hourly tours of the capitol. See the Missouri Veterans Memorial.

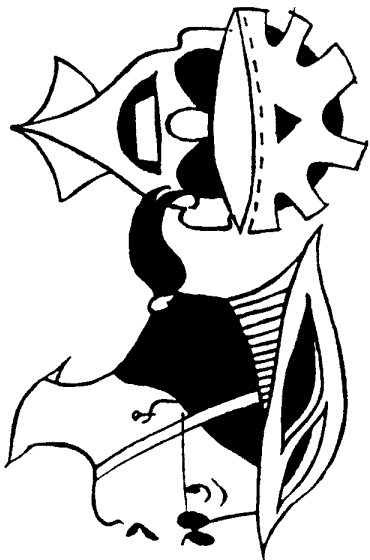
HERMAN: Visit the 1894 and More Museum which displays old photos, deeds, handtools, a beautiful organ, kerosene lamps, and much more.

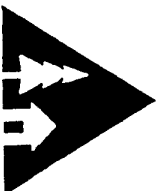
